Gladstone Beach ~ Van Cleve Park

Enjoy the beauty of our sand beach and the amenities and activities our park has to offer the public including the Skate Park, Fishing Pier, Kids Kingdom, Tot Lot, Beach House and spacious picnic areas.

Our beach house is equipped with hot showers and restrooms. The beach sand and shoreline are clean and maintained.



Life guarded beach during normal hours of operation from 1pm-6pm daily.

Swimming lessons available. Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced. This two-week program is geared towards waterfront safety and swimming skills. *Lessons run from July 10 through July 21.*

Pram Sailing lessons. For youth, 8 years of age and older, that have passed beginner level swimming, this is your chance to learn to sail. Prams are flat bottomed two-person sailboats. Each summer, 10 prams hit the water off the Gladstone Marina. Participants receive hands-on instruction. Once skills have been mastered, free sailing times are offered on weekday afternoons. *Lessons TBA.*
