Now that the lovely white snow had fully arrived for the winter, the Public Safety department wishes to remind everyone of the parking regulations for the City that are in affect from December 1st through March 31st. During all hours, no parking is allowed on the South side of any avenue and on the West side of any street. There is also no overnight parking allowed on either side of the avenues or streets between the hours of 3:30am and 6:30am.

The regulations for the downtown area are a bit more stringent in that vehicles that are parked in the following designated areas may be ticketed and towed away at the owner’s expense if they are parked there from the 3:30am to 6:30am hours.

Delta Ave from 6th Street to 14th Street.

8th Street from Superior Ave to Minnesota Ave.

9th Street from Superior Ave to Minnesota Ave.

10th Street from Superior Ave to Lake Shore Drive

11th Street from Superior Ave to Minnesota Ave.

All parking violations result in a \$20.00 fine be assessed. All the winter parking rules are in place to ensure that our streets can be adequately kept clear and accessible for all traffic, which includes emergency vehicles.

ATTENTION ALL PROPERTY OWNERS AND TENANTS!

The snow season is upon us! The City of Gladstone would like to remind residents that our town is a year round playground and as such many residents are out and about all winter long enjoying the great outdoors. To accommodate outdoor activity Gladstone's snow removal ordinance requires that public sidewalks be cleared of all snow and ice within 48 hours after a snowfall in residential districts and within 24 hours in the business district after any accumulation has stopped. Property owners are responsible for the removal of snow and ice from all sidewalks that border their private property; including any approaches that may extend toward the street. Tenants – please check your leases to see if your landlord has transferred that responsibility to you. The sidewalk must be cleared the entire width of the sidewalk down to concrete.
