LOOSE IN YOUR CURBSIDE CART OR BROUGHT IN TO LANDFILL
(DO NOT put in plastic bags!!)

1. CARDBOARD

Remove any shipping materials,
break down and flatten boxes.

2. MIXED PAPER

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail,
office paper, cereal and food boxes.

3. PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Clean and empty food and beverage containers,
soap bottles and jugs, empty pill bottles.

4. METAL CONTAINERS

Clean and empty aluminum & metal
food and beverage containers.

NO GLASS, PLASTIC BAGS or STYROFOAM!!

Steel Food Cans and Aerosol Cans	Corrugated Cardboard & Empty Brown Paper Bags	Office Paper and Junk Mail
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse Well (Label May Stay On) Must Be completely Empty Remove Plastic Lid unless it's Part of the Steel Can and Remove any Plastic nozzle. <p>Do not Include: Loose lids, Covers, and Caps. (To recycle tin can lid, place it inside the can and gently squeeze the top.)</p> <p>Note* A magnet will "stick" to steel, but not aluminum.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flatten <p><u>Do not Include:</u> Packaging Peanuts, Styrofoam, Plastic Liners, Food Contaminated Paper, Wax Coated Boxes, Juice Boxes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please Bag ONLY if Pre-shredded. Staples and Paper clips allowed. <p>ABSOLUTELY NO CARBON PAPER</p> <p>Do Not include: Wax Paper, Transfer Paper, Paper Toweling, Label Backing, Books, Metals, Plastic, Rubber Bands, Food Wrappers, Used Tissue and Toilet Paper.</p>
