<u>LOOSE</u> IN YOUR CURBSIDE CART OR BROUGHT IN TO LANDFILL (DO NOT put in plastic bags!!)

1. CARDBOARD

Remove any shipping materials, break down and flatten boxes.

2. MIXED PAPER

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, cereal and food boxes.

3. PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Clean and empty food and beverage containers, soap bottles and jugs, empty pill bottles.

4. METAL CONTAINERS

Clean and empty aluminum & metal food and beverage containers.

NO GLASS, PLASTIC BAGS or STYROFOAM!!
